



KNOWLEDGE & REFLECTIONS



PROF. DR. SUSHMA ACQUILLA (BATCH 1966) FRCP, FFPHM, ILTHM, MILM, DCH, FRSM, LRCP, MRCS

Professor Sushma Acquilla is a globally recognized public health leader, with a distinguished career spanning over four decades in the UK's National Health Service (NHS). She held key leadership positions including Program Director for the National Public Health Leadership Program, Postgraduate Dean for multiple Deaneries, and Director of Public Health. Her work has shaped the careers of hundreds of public health professionals in the UK.

Beyond the NHS, Professor Acquilla has made exceptional contributions to international public health. She has served as Chair of the BMA Conference Committee, Vice Chair of the Global Health Committee of the Royal College of Physicians, and International Faculty Advisor to the Faculty of Public Health (UK). She has advised WHO, the Indian Ministry of Health, and the Public Health Foundation of India, and led major initiatives in India, Europe, and the Middle East to develop competency-based public health training.

Her work has earned her numerous accolades, including the Wilfred Harding Prize, Lifetime Achievement Medals in Global Health, and the Baum Prize for her role in the Bhopal disaster investigation. She continues to serve as Director of SDAcquilla Consultancy, Managing Director of Bellevue Health Care, and holds leadership roles in community organizations. Her career reflects a lifelong commitment to public service, global health advancement, and medical education.

DR. DEEPAK LACHHWANI (BATCH: 1982)

Dr. Lachhwani is a dedicated clinician who has pursued his passion for pediatric epilepsy for over two decades. At the Cleveland Clinic, his work has combined high-level clinical care with a commitment to medical education and research. He has made significant contributions to pediatric epilepsy surgery, trained numerous residents and fellows, delivered invited lectures globally, and authored research papers, book chapters, and editorials in the field.



He has been actively involved with the American Epilepsy Society (AES), holding several key roles. Notably, he cochaired the inaugural Pediatric Highlights Session at AES 2004, which has since become a mainstay of the annual meeting. He also served as editor of AES News and contributed to committees focused on pediatric content, scientific programming, and communications.

From 2014 to 2018, Dr. Lachhwani led the development of a comprehensive neurology service at Cleveland Clinic Abu Dhabi (CCAD). Under his leadership, the neurology department expanded into a fully staffed 24/7 service across major subspecialties. He also established the first International Virtual Epilepsy Monitoring Unit in collaboration with Cleveland Clinic USA, and chaired the region's pioneering Conflict of Interest and Innovations Management Committee. Through these roles, he continues to advance care and innovation in the global epilepsy community.



DR. AMIT SOOD (BATCH 1984)

Dr. Amit Sood is an internationally acclaimed physician, researcher, and wellness expert whose career spans premier institutions across India and the United States. After earning his MBBS from Barkatullah University and completing an MD in Medicine at AllMS New Delhi, he moved to the U.S., where he trained at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine and later at the University of Arizona. He joined the Mayo Clinic in 2005, becoming a full Professor of Medicine by 2013. At Mayo, he led the Mind-Body

Medicine Initiative and served as enterprise chair for student life and wellness. He currently serves as CEO of the Global Center for Resiliency and Well-being and holds fellowships with Atria Health and UC Berkeley.

A pioneer in the field of stress and resilience, Dr. Sood has developed widely adopted programs like SMART©, Resilient Option, and Happy Genius. His interventions, tested in over 35 clinical trials, are used by major institutions including Mayo Clinic, Delta Air Lines, PepsiCo, and NYP Health System, impacting over 250,000 people annually. His NIH-funded research focuses on burnout, mindfulness, well-being, and emotional resilience across populations.

Dr. Sood has authored more than 80 scientific publications and several bestselling books, including The Mayo Clinic Guide to Stress-Free Living and The Resilience Journal. His work has been featured in The New York Times, Wall Street Journal, Time Magazine, and NPR. A celebrated speaker, he has presented at TEDx, NASA, the Forbes Under 30 Forum, and more. His contributions have earned him numerous honors, including the Mayo Clinic's Outstanding Physician-Scientist Award and the Robert Wood Johnson Health Care Pioneer Award.
